The displayed machines cover a wide range of applications - from an entry level four-spindle paper drill to a high speed in-line paper drilling system with an output of 1,400 piles / hour.



The Dürselen products shown at IPEX address to trade binderies, commercial printers with finishing department and include specialist machines for e.g. drilling of multiple holes for wire comb binding and large hole drilling. Efficiency, flexibility and easy operation are the characteristics of Dürselen paper drilling machines. The presentation in the "G.A.E. netWORKflow zone" at IPEX shows the way to high tech paper drilling.

In detail the following models are shown:

- PB.04 N – a modern, completely equipped and highly flexible four-spindle paper drill for changing applications and materials.
- UD-04 – an entry-level four-spindle paper drill for small to medium volumes and standard applications
- PB.16 – a multi-spindle paper drill up to 15 drill heads, with programmable sliding table and touch screen control
- PB.15 – a high-speed paper drill including jogger and multi-hole function; in-line and off-line operation; up to 1,400 piles / hour



Additionally Dürselen presents accessories and specialist equipment for modern paper drilling like e.g. drill belts as drilling support, drill bit sharpeners or special drill heads for drilling of narrow hole spacing..
